Hochschild draws on her expert knowledge of the sociology of emotion to help us understand what it *feels* like to live in “red” America. Along the way she finds answers to one of the crucial questions of contemporary American politics: why do the people who would seem to benefit most from “liberal” government intervention abhor the very idea?
